About Last Night

- Well 3 games last night – nice to see the usual variety of armies used. Nik's Hamdanid's (Dynastic Bedouin) took on Martin's Palmyrans in a battle of the desert dwellers☺ that resulted in an honourable draw; Dave's NKE suffered from a 3000 year technology gap versus Graham's Ilkhanids (with Cilician Armenian back up); and finally my Later Ottoman fought a fairly bloody draw with Steve's Seljuqs (backed up with more Ilkhanids as an ally) which saw both camps looted! I have to say the advantage at the end of the game lay with Steve but the draw was a result of the fact that despite losing more APs my army was 4 BGs bigger than Steve's
- This means Graham has taken 1st place, Terry is in 2nd and Jason 3rd, but clearly early doors.
